I. Responsibilities of Chalet Host(s):

- a. The Chalet Host is to reside at The Government Peak Recreation Area for the time agreed upon, with a primary responsibility of unlocking and locking chalet doors and main gate on evenings and weekends, reporting any actions or presence of others that may result in vandalism to the property. The Host **will not** attempt to stop any vandalism or suspected vandalism. They will call the proper authorities to report any vandalism or unauthorized personnel if they can do so without putting themselves in danger.
- b. The Chalet Hosts must be aware of the Mat-Su Borough's restrictions at Government Peak Recreational Area. GPRA prohibiting firearms, weapons, alcoholic beverages, and controlled substances on Borough property.
- c. Motorhomes, trailers, 5th Wheels, etc. must present a well-maintained appearance at all times. The Chalet Host area is to be kept clean and free of litter. Pets are allowed with approval. Chalet Hosts are required to clean up after their pets.

II. Mat Su Trails and Parks Foundation will provide:

- a. Water and electric hook-ups. The Camper Host must provide a water hose and electrical cord.
- b. Sewage disposal service. Sewage pumping service to empty the camper's holding tank shall be made available once weekly upon request.
- c. Any additional special arrangements agreed upon by the Chalet Host and the Mat Su Trails and Park Foundation shall be noted here:
